Important Information regarding bags:

The Return-It Express system requires a standard, commercially available "Blue" recycling bag or "Transparent" bag. This allows employees to see inside, ensuring the contents are safe to process. Bags can be purchased at most stores. There are many acceptable brands to choose from, including the more popular brands below:

CSA approved helmets are mandatory for all CanSkate, PowerSkate and Junior StarSkate Skaters. Pre CanSkaters must wear CSA approved helmets with face cages.

Coaches would like all skaters in levels Star 1 and up to wear "Crasche" or "Halo" protective headbands. Any skater not wearing head protection may be limited in the new skills being taught to them and coaches have the right to take any precaution they feel necessary on the ice any time a skater is not wearing head protection. Coaches may ask skaters in Star 1 and up to remove their head protection if they feel the skater(s) need to practice without it.
